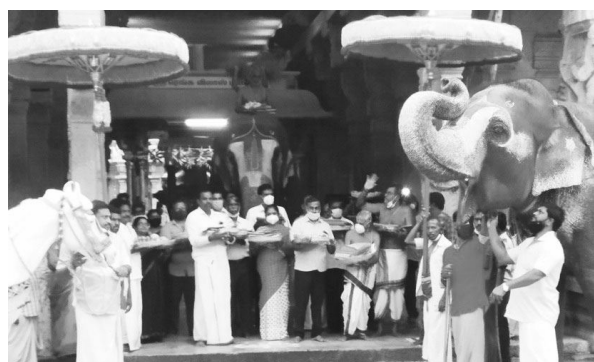


Srirangam temple performs 'Vastra Mariyadhai' to Lord of Tirumala Hills

Tiruchi, July 16: To thankfully acknowledge the Tirumala Tirupathi Devasthanam, Tirupathi, for keeping safely the statue of the Sri Ranganthar in the temple for over 50 years during the Muslim invasion, and also to commemorate the historical event, the Srirangam temple performed the Vastra Mariyadhai recently to the Lord of Seven Hills.



Silk dhoti, flowers, paste and an umbrella fruits, sandalwood were carried from the

Srirangam temple to offer at the Tirumala Hills temple for adoration to the presiding deity of the temple on the first day of the Tamil month Aadi begins Saturday. Vastra Mariyadhai is an yearly event and the gifts of honour were taken around the four Uthira streets before its onward journey to Tirupathi. According to sources from the Srirangam temple, during the Muslim king invasions, the Namperumal Sri Ranganathan, stayed in Tirumala. The sources also said that it is believed that in the earlier days Pooja articles, including flowers, used to be taken to Tirumala temple from Srirangam by devotees and the two temples exchanged honours in those days.

Joint Commissioner of Srirangam temple Marimuthu, Chief Priest Sundar Bhattar and various employees of the temple participated in the Vastra Mariyadhai procession.
